The Appraisal Review Board is a five-member board that will hear evidence on disputes of value, exemptions, ownership, special appraisal, unequal appraisals, and others. Members serve 2-year terms, staggered and vacancies are typically appointed in/by January of each year. You may visit with the Chief Appraiser regarding duties, time requirements and other questions you may have - until appointed. After appointment, it is legally prohibited.

The action of the Appraisal Review Board is strictly governed by the Property Tax Code and the office of Property Tax Assistance Division of the Texas Comptroller. There is an annual training requirement, along with a commitment for attendance from May through late July. You will be required to obtain certificates of training for Open Meetings and Open Records Act

ARB members hear and weigh only evidence presented in an open hearing. There are strict rules governing communications with CAD employees, property owners and fellow ARB members outside of that specific hearing.

ARB members cannot appraise property, present evidence or act on information NOT submitted during hearing procedures. ARB members are not ADVOCATES. Decisions are based on preponderance of evidence in determining a Total PROPERTY Value. ARB, nor CAD, has anything to do with TAXES. The responsibility is as judge, advocating for owner, CAD or any tax unit is prohibited by law. ARB members may be reviewed for Tax Code violations and/or actions of bias and rulings not based on evidence.

Travel for training is paid at IRS mileage rate. Meals are reimbursed meals. There is a nominal stipend paid of \$60 per each half day of service.
